The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) requests that the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to Section 386.440 RSMo and 4 CSR 240-2.100 issue a subpoena duces tecum for the attendance of, and production of documentary evidence (as specified in the attached Subpoena Duces Tecum) by, Peter N. Brown at a deposition beginning on April 27, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. and continuing thereafter until excused, at 1 Court Circle, Camdenton, Missouri 65020, in the Camden County Prosecutor's Office meeting room. In PSC Cases SR-2010-0110 and WR-2010-0111, Lake Region Water & Sewer Company has requested a rate increase, whereby jurisdiction over and possible treatment of availability fees allegedly collected under the name Four Season's Water & Sewer Company, Four Season's Lakesites, Inc., Lake Utility Availability or Lake Utility Availability 1 and related to utility service are at issue. Peter N. Brown is the former president of Four Season's Water & Sewer Company). Furthermore, the deposition of Peter N. Brown, along with presentation of the documentary evidence requested, will lead to the discovery of evidence that the Missouri Public Service Commission ordered Staff to obtain in its April 8, 2010 Order Directing Discovery and Directing Filing.
