ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

Issue Date: October 7, 2005

Effective Date: October 20, 2005

On June 17, 2004, the Commission granted Inter-Tel NetSolutions, Inc., a certificate of service authority to provide basic local exchange, non-switched local exchange, and exchange access telecommunications services. In that order, the Commission waived its requirement that Inter-Tel NetSolutions immediately file an implementing tariff. However, the order provided that Inter-Tel NetSolutions' certificates of service authority would not become effective until its tariff became effective.

On September 16, 2005, Inter-Tel NetSolutions filed a local exchange tariff. The proposed tariff carried an effective date of October 17, but Inter-Tel NetSolutions subsequently extended the effective date of the tariff until October 20. Inter-Tel NetSolutions also filed substitute sheets on October 3.

The Commission's Staff filed a recommendation regarding the proposed tariff on October 5. Staff states that it has no objection to the proposed tariff taking effect on October 20, as requested by Inter-Tel NetSolutions.

Based on the recommendation of its Staff, the Commission will approve the submitted tariff. With the approval of its tariff, Inter-Tel NetSolutions' certificate of service authority will become effective.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff filed September 16 2005, and assigned Tariff No. YC-2005-0206, is approved, as substituted, to become effective on October 20, 2005:

2. That this order shall become effective on October 20, 2005.
3. That this case may be closed on October 21, 2005.
