ORDER SHORTENING INTERVENTION DEADLINE
AND DIRECTING FILING

On April 5, 2005, Missouri Network Alliance, L.L.C., filed its application for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services in portions of the state of Missouri. Along with its application, the company filed a proposed tariff with an effective date of May 20, 2005. Also on April 5, 2005, Missouri Network Alliance filed a motion for expedited treatment, requesting that the Commission grant its application for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service by May 20, 2005.

On April 19, 2005, the Commission issued a Notice of Applications which provides that requests for intervention shall be filed no later than May 19, 2005. In order to facilitate a timely resolution to this matter, the Commission will shorten the time for the filing applications to intervene. The Commission will also direct its Staff to expeditiously file its Recommendation and Memorandum.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That applications to intervene shall be filed no later than May 4, 2005.

2. Responses to any application to intervene shall be filed no later than May 10, 2005.

3. That the Staff of the Commission shall file its Recommendation and Memorandum no later than May 13, 2005.

4. That this order shall become effective on April 20, 2005.
