STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), through the undersigned counsel, and hereby respectfully submits this Staff Recommendation.

- 1. On December 20, 2018, the above-referenced Wisper ISP, Inc. ("Company") filed notice that it had purchased the stock of Your Home Town Internet, Inc., which resulted in the acquisition of the assets, certificate to provide basic local telecommunications services and interconnected voice over internet protocol (IVoIP) registration in Missouri of Aurora Communications, Inc. This transfer also results in services being provided in Missouri under the name Wisper ISP, Inc., going forward. The Company filed all requisite documentation.
- 2. Rule 4 CSR 240-28.011(2) provides that any company with a certificate or registration that changes its name shall provide advance notice to the Commission of the name change and lays out the methods and requirements for such notice. In lieu of a Memorandum, Staff herein states that the Company has complied with the rule. No entities intervened to oppose the name change. The Company is not delinquent in any required filings with the Commission.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission recognize the name change and grant such other and further relief as is just in the circumstances.
