**MOTION FOR WAIVER OF FILING OF EVIDENCE OF FINANCIAL RESOURCES**

Tennessee Telephone Service, LLC dba Freedom Communications USA, LLC ("Applicant"), a Delaware Corporation, hereby moves for a waiver of the requirements of 4 CSR 240-3.510(D)(1), concerning evidence of financial resources, and files herewith the affidavit of Matt Davis to demonstrate its financial ability to provide basic local telecommunications service in Missouri. In support of this Motion, the Applicant states the following:

1. The Applicant filed its application on September 28, 2009, and a supplement to the application on November 4, 2009.

2. Under 4 CSR 240-3.510(D)(1), applicants for basic local exchange authority are required to file certain financial information, for the purpose of demonstrating their ability to provide basic local exchange service. The Applicant hereby requests a waiver of that requirement, and submits for the Commission's consideration the affidavit of Matt Davis, in which Mr. Davis swears that the Applicant has the financial ability to provide basic local exchange service in Missouri. It has not defaulted on any financial obligation within the past three years, and has access to sufficient financial resources to support its provision of local exchange services. Given the content of Mr. Davis' affidavit, the financial information require

by the rule is unnecessary.

Wherefore, for good cause shown the Applicant moves for waiver of 4 CSR 240-3.510(D)(1) and requests that the Commission consider the attached affidavit of Matt Davis in support of its application.


