**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR LEAVE TO WITHDRAW INTERVENTION**

On November 12, 2009, the Commission granted Pemiscot-Dunklin Electric Cooperative's application to intervene in this matter. On November 13, 2009, Pemiscot-Dunklin requested leave to withdraw its intervention. Pemiscot-Dunklin states that the City of Campbell, Missouri, has indicated to it that the City has accepted a bid from Ozark Border Electric Cooperative to purchase the City's electric distribution system, in preference to Pemiscot-Dunklin's contract to purchase the system. In reliance upon this change of status, Pemiscot-Dunklin no longer opposes the Applicants' request to receive electric service from Ozark Border.

The Commission will grant Pemiscot-Dunklin's request to withdraw its intervention.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Pemiscot-Dunklin Electric Cooperative's Request for Leave to Withdraw Intervention is granted.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall remove Pemiscot-Dunklin Electric Cooperative as a party to this case.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
