On September 1, 2010, the Commission dismissed Donna Hawley from this case because of her failure to comply with a Commission order, issued on July 30, that required her to file a list of issues, order of witnesses, order of cross-examination, opening and closing. On September 2, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to reconsider its order dismissing Ms. Hawley from the case. On September 3, Ms. Hawley filed a Motion to Request Extention (sic) to File Reconsideration (sic), and on September 7, she filed a Motion to Request Reconsideration of Commission's Order of Dismissal.

The Commission has considered Public Counsel's and Ms. Hawley's arguments, but is not persuaded by them. The Commission will deny their motions for reconsideration.

Public Counsel's motion for reconsideration was accompanied by a motion for expedited treatment requesting a prompt ruling from the Commission because the hearing on the underlying case is set to begin on September 8. The Commission agrees that a prompt ruling is appropriate, but the Commission will not have an agenda meeting before the beginning of the hearing. Therefore, the Commission delegates authority to issue this order to its Chief Regulatory Law Judge.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Public Counsel's Motion for Reconsideration is denied.
- 2. Donna Hawley's Motion to Request Reconsideration of Commission's Order

of Dismissal is denied.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
