Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, has applied to the Commission to extend its authority to continue the transfer of functional control of its electric transmission system to the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. On March 21, 2011, the parties filed a status report indicating they are continuing to discuss Ameren Missouri's application. The parties report they may be able to resolve the application through the filing of a stipulation and agreement and ask that they be allowed until May 16 to file an additional status report regarding the results of their negotiations.

The parties' request is reasonable and the Commission will direct the parties to file their next status report no later than May 16.
