- 3. On September 19, 2003, the Commission issued its Order Setting Prehearing Conference. In that Order, the Commission set the Prehearing Conference for September 26, 2003 at 11:00 a.m.
- 4. The parties are currently engaged in discussions in an attempt to address the issues the MITG and STCG have raised. In order to facilitate further discussions and permit the parties to focus their efforts on a resolution to the claims that have been made, SBC Missouri seeks to continue the Prehearing Conference from September 26, 2003 until October 3, 2003.
