On March 8, 2016, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed an Application for Approval of Demand-Side Programs Budget Modifications. GMO asks the Commission to modify the budget to allow GMO to continue paying for completed MEEIA Cycle 1 program applications.

The Commission will direct its Staff to file a recommendation, and will allow other parties an opportunity to respond.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file its recommendation regarding GMO's Application for Approval of Demand-side Programs Budget Modifications no later than April 4, 2016.
2. Any other party who wishes to respond shall do so no later than April 4, 2016.
