On February 14, 2014¹, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren”), filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking permission and authority to issue and sell up to \$350 million aggregate principal amount of additional long-term indebtedness. Ameren asks the Commission to expedite its consideration of its application, explaining it needs to finance within a limited window caused by the release dates of its earnings report and required Security and Exchange Commission filings. To that end, Ameren asks the Commission to approve its application on or before March 19.

The Commission will order Staff to respond expeditiously by filing either a recommendation or, in the alternative, a status report stating when Staff plans to file its recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall respond as ordered above no later than March 5, 2014.
