**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A PLEADING STATING  
WHEN IT WILL FILE A RECOMMENDATION**

On May 15, 2014, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("Company") filed an application seeking authority from the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") to issue up to \$350 million principal amount of debt securities through June 30, 2016, and to enter into interest rate hedging instruments in connection with such debt securities. The Commission will need a recommendation from its Staff before acting on the Company's application. Therefore, the Commission will direct its Staff to respond indicating when it will be able to file a recommendation in this matter.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No later than May 29, 2014, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a pleading stating when it anticipates filing its recommendation in this matter.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
