ORDER PROVIDING NOTICE AND ESTABLISHING
INTERVENTION DEADLINE

In its May 17, 2007 Report and Order in Case No. ER-2007-0004, the Commission directed Aquila to complete a heat rate and/or efficiency schedule and testing plan.¹ On November 9, 2007, Aquila filed a Motion to Establish a Docket for Approval of Heat Rate Schedule and Testing Plan, which resulted in the opening of this case. Aquila asks the Commission to approve the proposed heat rate and/or efficiency schedule and testing plan with written procedures Aquila submitted in conjunction with its motion.

In support of its motion Aquila states that it has not yet secured an agreement to its proposed procedures, schedules and manuals, from all parties to Case No. ER-2007-0004. Accordingly, although Aquila remains hopeful that a general agreement can be reached by all parties to Case No. ER-2007-0004, it is formally submitting this matter to the Commission for its approval in the event an agreement cannot be reached. The Commission will

provide notice of Aquila's request to other potential interested parties and the public, and will establish an intervention deadline.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this order to all parties to Case No. ER-2007-0004.

2. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Aquila, Inc.'s service area and to the members of the General Assembly representing Aquila, Inc.'s service area.

3. Any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than December 5, 2007. Such applications shall be filed with:
