ORDER DENYING MOTION TO JOIN AND CONSOLIDATE CASES

Issue Date: April 20, 2023 Effective Date: April 20, 2023

On March 7, 2023, Charles Harter filed a complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri. On March 17, 2023, Mr. Harter filed a motion to join and consolidate this case with File No. WC-2023-0106, which is a complaint filed against Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC). Mr. Harter asserts that the cases share a complainant and a common question as to whether a utility's claim of date of mailing absent a postmark provides the ten-day notice required by regulation.

On March 27, 2023, Ameren Missouri filed its response in opposition to Mr. Harter's motion to join and consolidate. Ameren Missouri argues that the two cases are on different schedules, that issues exist regarding confidentiality of certain information between the two

utilities, and differences in MAWC's notification procedures from its own may preclude consolidation of the two matters.

Consolidation of files is permissible under the rules of the Commission when there are related questions of law or fact.² The cases Mr. Harter seeks to have consolidated are cases brought against two utilities providing different types of service, governed by different regulations, and in different stages of development. Within each case, File No. EC-2023-0281 and File No. WC-2023-0106, Mr. Harter has filed identical petitions to amend a rule of the Commission regarding service of notice. The Commission has created a separate file to conisder Mr. Harter's petition, and assigned it File No. AX-2023-0287.

Aside from these rulemaking petition filings, there are no common issues of law or fact addressed in the complaints for which consolidation will avoid unnecessary costs or delay. As such, the Commission will deny Mr. Harter's motion to join and consolidate these cases.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Motion of Charles Harter to consolidate File Nos. EC-2023-0281 and WC-2023-0106 is denied.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
