ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION REPORT AND ORDER

Issue Date: March 1, 2006 Effective Date: March 8, 2006

In a Report and Order issued on October 19, 2005, the Commission granted Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) a variance from the separate meter requirements of its own tariffs to permit it to install a master meter for WallStreet Tower Condominiums in Kansas City, Missouri. KCPL issued a tariff sheet on January 30, 2006, that revises the list of separate metering variances contained in its existing tariffs, to include the variances for WallStreet Tower Condominiums and another project, which the Commission approved in 2003. KCPL's tariff sheet originally carried an effective date of March 5, but KCPL subsequently extended that effective date until March 8.

Staff filed its recommendation regarding KCPL's tariff on February 28. Staff indicates that the tariff complies with the Commission's Report and Order, and recommends that the Commission approve the tariff to become effective on March 8. No other party has filed a recommendation regarding the tariff.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission determines that the tariff complies with the Commission's Report and Order. The tariff will be approved effective March 8.
