ORDER DIRECTING KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY TO MEET WITH STAKEHOLDERS AND TO REPORT THE RESULTS OF THAT MEETING

On August 5, 2010, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) filed an application asking the Commission to waive a provision of its Electric Utility Resource Planning (IRP) regulation to allow KCP&L to delay filing its next IRP submission from August 5, 2011, until April 1, 2012. Subsequently, on August 25, KCP&L filed a motion seeking leave to amend its application for waiver to reflect the fact that its next IRP submission is currently due on November 5, 2011, not August 5, 2011. KCP&L's motion to amend its application is unopposed and the Commission will grant that motion.

The Commission provided notice of KCP&L's application to each party in KCP&L's 2008 IRP case, and directed interested parties to respond to the company's application by September 7, 2010. The Commission granted Dogwood Energy, LLC's request to intervene on August 24, and on August 26 Dogwood Energy filed its consent to KCP&L's request for an extension of its time to file its next IRP. On September 7, the Office of the

Public Counsel, Staff, and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources responded separately to KCP&L's request.

Public Counsel expresses concern about KCP&L upcoming IRP and objects to the company's request to delay the filing of its IRP. Public Counsel urges the Commission to defer ruling on KCP&L's request and instead schedule a conference at which the stakeholders can discuss KCP&L's request to delay the filing of its next IRP. Natural Resources and Staff agree that a conference would be helpful.

The Commission agrees that a conference among the stakeholders would be appropriate. That conference does not need to be on-the-record and the Commission does not need to be directly involved in the conference. Instead, the Commission will direct KCP&L and the other stakeholders to meet at a place and time of their choosing and report the results of their conference to the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Kansas City Power & Light Company shall meet with interested stakeholders, at a time and location acceptable to the stakeholders, to discuss its proposal to delay the filing of its next IRP from November 5, 2011, to April 1, 2012.
- 2. No later than October 8, 2010, Kansas City Power & Light Company shall file a report regarding the results of the meeting required in the previous paragraph.
- 3. Any other participant in the meeting may file a separate report no later than October 8, 2010.
- 4. Kansas City Power & Light Company's Motion for Leave to Amend its Application for Waiver is granted.

5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
