ORDER GRANTING DOGWOOD ENERGY'S APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On August 5, 2010, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) filed an application asking the Commission to waive a provision of its Electric Utility Resource Planning (IRP) regulation to allow KCP&L to delay filing its next IRP submission from August 5, 2011, until April 1, 2012. In response, on August 5, the Commission provided notice of KCP&L's filing to potentially interested parties.

Dogwood Energy. LLC applied to intervene on August 10¹. Dogwood owns a 655 MW combined cycle generating facility located within the MPS service territory of KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company. Dogwood asks to intervene in KCP&L's IRP case because it wants to protect its access to transmission and power supplies in the region. More than ten days have passed since Dogwood applied to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

The Commission finds that Dogwood's interest in this case differs from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing Dogwood to intervene will serve the public

interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Dogwood Energy, LLC's Application to Intervene is granted.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
