ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On April 28, 2014, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") requested a variance from certain portions of the Commission's Electric Utility Renewable Energy Standard Requirements rule in 4 CSR 240-20.100. On May 7, 2014, Missouri Solar Energy Industries Association ("MOSEIA") filed a timely motion to intervene. MOSIEA represents solar industry stakeholders supporting policies focused on solar job creation and sustainable economic growth in Missouri. MOSIEA has an interest in the implementation and enforcement of the Renewable Energy Standard Requirements and the solar rebate program that is different from the general public. Its interests may be adversely impacted by a final order in the file.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3) authorizes the Commission to grant an application to intervene if the party has an interest different from that of the general public which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. No party objected to MOSEIA's motion.

Upon review of the unopposed application, the Commission finds MOSEIA meets the standards set in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3). Therefore, the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Missouri Solar Energy Industries Association's *Application to Intervene* is granted.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
