**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION AND ESTABLISHING TIME
TO INTERVENE OR TO OBJECT TO REQUEST FOR VARIANCE**

On April 28, 2014, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") asked the Commission to grant it a variance from certain portions of the Commission's Electric Utility Renewable Energy Standard Requirements rule in 4 CSR 240-20.100. Ameren Missouri is requesting a variance from Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100.4(K), to allow an additional month for inspections of customers' solar electric systems by certain jurisdictional authorities. Ameren Missouri is also requesting variance from the date by which it must provide solar rebate payments to those customers.

The Commission will order a Staff recommendation and will establish a time to apply to intervene or to object to the request for variance.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation no later than May 13, 2014 regarding Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Application for Variance.

2. Any motion to intervene or asking the Commission to reject Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Application for Variance must be filed no later than May 13, 2014.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
