**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DEADLINES FOR
INTERVENTION APPLICATIONS AND STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION**

On July 29, 2022, Evergy Missouri Metro, Inc. (Evergy Metro) submitted direct testimony and a tariff designed to implement an adjustment to its Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment Clause (FAC) in File No. ER-2023-0030. This FAC tariff filing includes costs from January through June of 2022. This filing consists of actual fuel and purchased power costs, net of off-system sales revenues incurred by Evergy Metro. The proposed FAC tariff bears an effective date of October 1, 2022.

Evergy Metro also submitted an application in File Number EO-2023-0029 containing its true-up filing for its FAC. Under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(4), the Staff of the Commission (Staff) shall submit a recommendation regarding the proposed adjustment no later than 30 days after its filing. No later than 60 days after receiving the proposed adjustment, the Commission must: (1) enter an interim rate adjustment; (2) approve or reject the tariff as submitted; or (3) allow the tariff to go into

effect by operation of law. Consequently, the Commission shall issue notice, set an intervention deadline, and direct its Staff to file a recommendation.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-3.161(10) provides that parties to the rate case in which the Commission approved Evergy Metro's fuel adjustment clause are automatically parties to this tariff case, without the necessity of having to apply for intervention. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that the parties to File No. ER-2018-0145 (the file in which Evergy Metro's FAC was most recently re-approved) are parties to this case, and it will direct its Data Center to add those parties to the service list.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall add the parties to File No. ER-2018-0145 to the service list for these cases and shall provide those parties with a copy of this order.

2. The Commission's Data Center shall provide notice of this order to the county commissions for each county in Evergy Metro's Missouri service territory.

3. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of this order to news media serving residents in Evergy Metro's Missouri service territory and members of the General Assembly representing residents in Evergy Metro's Missouri service territory.

4. Applications for intervention shall be filed no later than August 16, 2022. Any such filing shall be submitted through the Commission's electronic filing and information system (EFIS) or delivered to: Secretary, Missouri Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, MO 65102-0360.

5. Staff shall file recommendations regarding its examination and analysis of Every Metro's application and proposed tariff sheet no later than August 26, 2022.

6. The order shall be effective when issued.
