ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S RENEWED APPLICATION FOR WAIVER

Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) has filed an application asking the Commission to waive a provision of its Electric Utility Resource Planning (IRP) regulation to allow KCP&L to delay filing its next IRP submission from November 5, 2011, until April 1, 2012. In their responses to that application, filed on September 7, the Commission's Staff, the Office of the Public Counsel, and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources asked the Commission to delay ruling on KCP&L's application until the interested parties had an opportunity to informally discuss the application with KCP&L. The Commission agreed with that suggestion and ordered KCP&L to meet with interested stakeholders and report the results of that meeting by October 8.

On October 7, KCP&L reported the meeting had been productive and indicated the company and the stakeholders might reach a consensus agreement through additional meetings. Those additional meetings were held and KCP&L filed additional reports. In its third report, filed on November 5, KCP&L stated the meetings had not resulted in an agreement and requested additional time to reassess its position. In its fourth report, filed on November 19, KCP&L reiterated its request to delay filing its next IRP submission from

November 5, 2011, until April 1, 2012. Because the November 5, 2011 submission deadline is rapidly approaching, KCP&L asks the Commission to rule on its request expeditiously.

Before taking any further action, the Commission will give the interested stakeholders an opportunity to offer suggestions on how the Commission should proceed to consider KCP&L's application. In particular, the Commission would like to know whether any party requests an evidentiary hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Any party that wishes to offer suggestions on how the Commission should proceed to consider Kansas City Power & Light Company's Application for Waiver shall do so no later than November 30, 2010.
- 2. Any party that wishes to request an evidentiary hearing regarding Kansas City Power & Light Company's Application for Waiver shall do so no later than November 30, 2010.
 - 3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
