CORRECTED ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On February 7, 2013, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") asked the Commission to grant it variances from certain requirements of the Commission's Integrated Resource Planning Rule, 4 CSR 240-22. GMO asks the Commission to extend the date for filing its 2013 Annual Update Report and its 2013 Annual Update Workshop by three months.

The Commission allowed time for potentially interested parties to respond to GMO's request. Dogwood Energy, LLC ("Dogwood") responded, asking the Commission to impose certain condition that GMO would not enter into commitments contrary to the results of the studies it has agreed to perform in connection with the 2013 Annual Update Report.

GMO responded to Dogwood's request on March 1, stating that the condition is acceptable only as it applies to resources sought in the January, 2013 RFP and the condition should expire with the filing of the 2013 Annual Update Report in June, 2013. Dogwood responded on March 7, "hoping" that GMO would have no objection to its condition. Dogwood states that its condition would expire on its own as GMO fulfills its commitments instead of using an arbitrary timeline GMO espouses.

As the parties do not appear to have an agreement, the Commission will order the parties to state how they would like to proceed. The Commission's prior order this date required Dogwood to respond. Instead, the Commission's intent was to order GMO to respond. This order corrects the Commission's earlier order this date.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company shall respond no later than
 March 14, 2013.
- 2. Any other party wishing to respond shall do so no later than March 14, 2013.
 - 3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
