NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY

Issue Date: April 25, 2022

On March 10, 2022, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri) filed a request for a variance from Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-22.080(1)(C), and a waiver of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1). Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1) requires that an applicant file a notice at least 60 days before filing their application. Ameren Missouri did not file the required notice.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1)(D) provides that good cause for a waiver of the 60-day notice requirement may include “a verified declaration from the filing party that is has had no communication with the office of the commission within the prior one hundred fifty (150) days regarding any substantive issue likely to be in the case or that circumstances prevented filing the required notice and delaying the filing for sixty (60) days would cause harm.”

Ameren Missouri’s application states: “A verified declaration meeting those requirements is attached to this request. Consequently, good cause has been established.” No verified declaration was attached to Ameren Missouri’s application.

The Commission will not take action on Ameren Missouri's request for waiver of the 60-day notice requirement of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1) until this deficiency is corrected.
