ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting each timely filed application for intervention ("motion").¹ Movants filed the motions as follows:

- *Missouri Department of Natural Resources' Application to Intervene* on March 4.²
- *Midwest Energy Users' Association Application to Intervene* on March 4.
- *Application for Intervention of Midwest Energy Consumer's Group* on March 7.

Any response was due on March 14. The motions are subject to the Commission's regulation 4 CSR 240-2.075(3):

The commission may grant a motion to intervene . . . if--

(A) The proposed intervenor . . . has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case; or

(B) Granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest.

Each motion meets that standard. No motion is the subject of any opposition. Therefore, the Commission will grant each motion.
