## ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On February 14, 2013<sup>1</sup>, Entergy Arkansas, Inc. ("EAI") filed the above-referenced application. EAI asks the Commission to decline jurisdiction over its transfer of functional control of its Missouri transmission facilities to MISO. The Commission set the case for hearing.

On April 29, EAI filed a Motion for Reconsideration. As ordered its Staff responded on May 9, and as permitted, KCP&L, GMO, Empire and MJMEUC ("Intervenors") also responded on May 9.

Staff correctly points out that although this case is set for hearing simultaneously with File No. EO-2013-0396, these cases are <u>not</u> consolidated. Staff stated that Intervenors have yet to advance a colorable argument that the Commission has jurisdiction to address any matters raised in their applications to intervene. Staff recommends that the Commission order Intervenors to state the legal authority the

Commission has over EAI's desire to move to MISO, and the facts they assert are in dispute.

Intervenors shall so respond.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Kansas City Power & Light Company, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, The Empire District Electric Company, and Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission shall respond as ordered above no later than May 17, 2013.
- 2. Any other party who wishes to respond shall do so no later than May 17, 2013.
  - 3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
