ORDER SHORTENING TIME FOR RESPONSE

The Missouri Public Service Commission shortening the time for filing a response to the Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Jurisdiction and for a Determination on the Pleadings and Motion for Expedited Treatment of Request to Cancel Hearing ("the motions"). Union Electric d/b/a AmerenUE filed the motions on September 23, 2009. The Commission's regulations provide:

Parties shall be allowed not more than ten (10) days from the date of filing in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the commission.¹

The Commission will order otherwise because only five days remain before the hearing and two of those days are Saturday and Sunday. Therefore, the Commission will shorten the response time.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party may file a response to the Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Jurisdiction and for a Determination on the Pleadings and Motion for Expedited Treatment of Request to Cancel Hearing no later than 3:00 p.m. on September 28, 2009.
