## ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE

Issue Date: June 9, 2009 Effective Date:June 9, 2009

On June 8, 2009, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend a tariff revision filed by Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE. Since AmerenUE's tariff is set to go into effect on June 13, the Commission will need to consider Public Counsel's motion at its June 10 agenda meeting.

Before acting on Public Counsel's motion to suspend the tariff, the Commission will direct AmerenUE and its Staff to respond to that motion. In particular, the Commission directs AmerenUE to file a copy of the cost-effectiveness analysis that is referenced in paragraph 4 of Public Counsel's motion. The Commission directs Staff to respond to Public Counsel's statement in paragraph 5 that the proposed Rider L program does not comply with the MISO Module E requirements for demand resources to qualify as a Load Modifying Resource. Furthermore, Staff shall respond to Public Counsel's statements in paragraph 10 regarding MISO market energy prices.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, shall file its response to Public Counsel's Motion to Suspend Tariff no later than 8:00 a.m. on June 10, 2009.

- 2. Staff shall file its response to Public Counsel's Motion to Suspend Tariff no later than June 9, 2009.
  - 3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
