ORDER DENYING STAFF'S MOTION TO REJECT TARIFF SHEETS AND ORDER CLOSING CASE

On February 21, 2012¹, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion to reject specific tariff sheets. Kansas City Power & Light ("KCP&L") responded on February 22, stating that Staff misidentified several tariff sheets and that KCP&L withdrew the tariff sheets it filed with the above-referenced application. Thus, KCP&L contends that Staff's motion is moot.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. The Commission issued no order to the contrary, and Staff did not respond within the allotted ten days.

Because KCP&L has withdrawn the tariff sheets in question, the Commission finds the motion moot, and will thus deny it. Also, because KCP&L has filed a notice of dismissal and has withdrawn the tariff sheets, the Commission shall close this case.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's Motion to Reject Tariff Sheets is denied.
