**ORDER APPROVING REVISED TECHNICAL
RESOURCE MANUAL AND DEEMED SAVINGS TABLE AND
GRANTING EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

On December 5, 2018, the Commission approved a stipulation and agreement in this case, which, among other things required Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri) to file an updated Technical Resource Manual (TRM), and an updated Deemed Savings Table. The Commission approved a revised TRM and Deemed Savings Table on February 27, 2019. On June 19, 2020, Ameren Missouri filed additional revisions to the TRM and Deemed Savings Table and a request that the Commission approved those changes no later than July 8, 2020, and make those changes effective on August 1, 2020.

Ameren Missouri explained that it is proposing program changes because of feedback it has received from customers, trade allies, and evaluators and has assessed the need for changes as the State of Missouri and local communities begin to lift stay at home orders related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Ameren Missouri stated that its BizSavers team has determined that several updates to Volume 2 (Business) of the TRM

are necessary to support small business and re-engage business customers. The proposed revisions are designed to:

- Add new measures such as more Variable Frequency drive options and large high volume/low speed fans, in order to offer more, and more relevant, products for customers in the building or agriculture operations;
- Modify existing measure attributes for several HVAC measures, Occupancy sensors, and Kitchen Demand Ventilation Controls, to better align deemed savings values with expected operations; and
- Include clean up items to add greater clarity and specificity within select measures, such as the application of the VSD Air Compressor incremental cost formula.

Ameren Missouri reported that it had shared its proposed changes with the Staff of the Commission and Staff supports these changes. The Commission directed any other responses be filed no later than June 29, 2020. No responses were filed.

The Commission has reviewed Ameren Missouri's request and determines that the revised TRM and Deemed Savings Table are in compliance with the Commission's December 5, 2018 order and will approve them. Additionally, because of the need to make these changes effective quickly to aid small businesses and re-engage business customers in Ameren Missouri's programs, the Commission will grant the motion for expedited treatment and make this order effective in less than 30 days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The revised Technical Resource Manual and Deemed Savings Table filed by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri on June 19, 2020, are approved.

2. This order is effective on August 1, 2020.
