PUBLIC COUNSEL'S RESPONSE TO JOINT AGREEMENT

The Office of Public Counsel (OPC) responds to the Joint Agreement as follows:

- 1. The Empire District Electric Company (Empire) filed its latest triennial compliance filing as for its integrated resource plan (IRP) on Jun 28, 2019.
- 2. The Staff of the Public Service Commission (Staff) issued its Report evaluating Empire's IRP compliance filing on February 28, 2020. Staff noted thirteen deficiencies and five areas of concern in Empire's filing.
- 3. Empire later met with Staff, the OPC, and other stakeholders to discuss Staff's findings, and the appropriate responses thereto.
- 4. Empire presented supplementary information, and pledged to undertake certain actions, that it believes alleviate Staff's findings of deficiencies and concerns. Empire describes its efforts in its Joint Agreement. The OPC does not agree with Empire's descriptions, and believes that the deficiencies and concerns persist notwithstanding Empire's actions.
- 5. However, Empire has also recently initiated the 2020 IRP Annual Update process in docket number EO-2020-0284. The OPC believes that the remaining deficiencies and concerns can be best addressed through the Annual Update's associated workshop and stakeholder engagement process, rather than continue to debate them in this forum. The OPC is not asking for a hearing regarding this disagreement at this time.

WHEREFORE, the OPC responds to the Joint Agreement.
