ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) has filed an application asking the Commission to approve a special incremental load rate for a steel production facility in Sedalia, Missouri. The existing procedural schedule established to consider that application, as previously extended, provided that rebuttal testimony was to be filed by the parties on September 16, 2019. No rebuttal testimony has thus far been filed.

On September 19, 2019, GMO, Nucor Steel Sedalia, and the Commission's Staff filed a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement that purports to resolve all issues regarding the special rate. Notably, two parties, the Office of the Public Counsel and Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG), did not sign the stipulation and agreement.

By rule, the parties that did not sign the stipulation and agreement have seven days, until September 26, 2019, to indicate their opposition to the stipulation and agreement. If the stipulation and agreement is opposed, the Commission will need to hear evidence to resolve the dispute. To that end, the Commission will modify the previously established procedural schedule to allow for the filing of rebuttal and surrebuttal testimony, while retaining the existing hearing dates.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural schedule is modified to provide:

- Rebuttal Testimony - September 27, 2019
- Surrebuttal Testimony - October 7, 2019
- List of Issues, Order of Witnesses, etc. - October 10, 2019
- Statements of Position - October 15, 2019
- Hearing - October 17 and 18, 2019
Beginning Each Day at 9:00 a.m.
- Initial Briefs - November 1, 2019
- Reply Briefs - November 8, 2019

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
