ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE OF **AQUILA AND MIEC**

Effective Date: November 27, 2007

On November 1, 2007, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, filed an application seeking authority to continue the control of its transmission system by the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (Midwest ISO). The Commission provided notice of the filing to potentially interested parties and established November 30 as an intervention deadline.

Aquila, Inc., filed an application to intervene on November 13. A group of companies identifying itself as the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) also applied to intervene on the same date.¹ No party has objected to either application to intervene.

The Commission finds that the interests of Aquila and MIEC in this case are different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing Aquila and MIEC to intervene

will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of Aquila, Inc., is granted.
2. The Application to Intervene of the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers is granted.
3. This order shall become effective on November 27, 2007.
