**ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING**

On February 19, 2009, the Commission issued an order approving KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's (KCP&L-GMO) tariff to adjust its rate schedules for its fuel adjustment clause. In approving the tariff, the Commission denied a motion to reject those tariffs filed by Ag Processing, Inc. and Sedalia Energy Users' Association. That order became effective on March 1. On February 26, Ag Processing and Sedalia Energy Users' Association filed a timely application for rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo (2000), indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." Ag Processing and Sedalia Energy Users' Association have not shown sufficient reason to rehear the Commission's order. The Commission will deny the application for rehearing.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Application for Rehearing filed by Ag Processing, Inc. and Sedalia Industrial Energy Users' Association is denied.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
