ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the Motion for Leave to Intervene ("the motion") filed by WIK, L.L.C. ("WIK").

On November 14, 2008, Sharon and Jerry West ("the Wests") instituted this action by filing an application for change of electrical supplier. WIK filed the motion on May 19, 2009.¹ As of the date of this order, no party has filed a response.²

The motion is subject to the following standard.

The proposed intervenor has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case[.³]

The motion alleges that WIK is also an owner of the property to which the Wests seek to change electrical supplier. Such allegation describes an interest that is different from that of the general public and that the Commission's decision may adversely affect. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

¹ An application for intervention is ordinarily due 30 days after the Commission issues notice of the case, which was on January 22, 2009. But the Commission may order otherwise. 4 CSR 240-2.075(1) and (5). The Commission's grounds for granting the motion also constitute grounds for allowing the late filing.

² The time to respond to any motion is generally ten days under 4 CSR 240-2.
