## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING INTERVENTION DATE

On May 29, 2009, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed an application containing the company's annual fuel adjustment clause true up to remedy an under collection of approximately \$1,100,000 for the territory formerly served by Aquila Networks-MPS and an under collection of approximately \$189,000 for the territory formerly served by Aquila Networks-L&P. KCPL-GMO asks the Commission to approve the under collection amounts as calculated by the company and to authorize KCPL-GMO to include those amounts in its next accumulation period.

The Commission will give notice of the filing of this tariff to the public and to others who may be interested. The Commission will also set a date for the filing of intervention requests. By rule, the parties to KCPL-GMO's most recent rate case, ER-2007-0004 are automatically parties to this case and do not need to file an application to intervene.
