ORDER SCHEDULING A PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND ALLOWING PARTIES TO FILE ADDITIONAL RESPONSES

On June 10, 2009, the Commission suspended a tariff filed by Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE from its original effective date of June 13 to July 9. The Commission also scheduled a hearing on that tariff for June 26.

Because this hearing is being expedited, the Commission's customary hearing procedure using prefiled testimony will not be applicable. Therefore, the Commission will schedule a prehearing conference so that the Commission and the parties can discuss the procedures to be used at this expedited hearing. In addition, the prehearing conference will allow the parties to discuss the issues that will be presented to the Commission for decision.

On June 11, AmerenUE filed a motion seeking clarification of the Commission's June 9 order that directed Staff and AmerenUE to quickly respond to Public Counsel's motion to suspend before the Commission's June 10 agenda meeting. AmerenUE filed a quick response in compliance with the Commission's order, but now wants to make a more detailed response. AmerenUE's motion for clarification asks whether the Commission's June 9 order precludes it from filing an additional response to Public Counsel's motion to suspend within the ten-day period normally allowed under the Commission's regulations.

The Commission clarifies that its June 9 order does not prevent AmerenUE, or any other party, from making any additional responsive filing within the time otherwise allowed by the Commission's regulation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. A prehearing conference is scheduled for June 19, 2009, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, Room 305.
