ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

In response to the Commission's order, issued February 22, 2010, the Staff of the Commission filed a joint motion on behalf of itself, Harold and Debbie Meyer, and counsel for the city of Marceline, Missouri, to convene a second prehearing conference. The participating parties¹ proposed April 29, 2010, at 10:00 a.m. for the conference, and requested that parties be allowed to participate by telephone.

The Commission will schedule the prehearing conference as requested and will establish a conference telephone line for parties who wish to appear and participate by telephone.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Joint Motion for Prehearing Conference filed on March 15, 2010, is granted.
2. A prehearing conference is scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m. on April 29, 2010, in the Commission's offices in the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Room 305, Jefferson City, Missouri. The Governor Office Building meets accessibility
