ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S REQUEST FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE STAFF REPORT

On August 5, 2008, Kansas City Power & Light Company (hereafter "KCPL") filed its Integrated Resource Plan. Per Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080, the Staff of the Commission (hereafter "Staff") must file a response to the plan 120 days thereafter, which would be on December 5.

On November 19, 2008, Staff filed its Request for Extension of Time to File Staff Report. Staff explains that due to the press of business in performing a prudence review of Aquila's fuel adjustment clause and in litigating the KCPL and AmerenUE rate cases, it needs until January 8, 2009 to file its report. Staff indicates that it has contacted all parties in this case, and that no party objects to Staff's request. Further, Staff states that this time extension should also apply to reports from the Office of the Public Counsel and to any intervenor's reports, so that they will also be due on January 8, 2009.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. However, in light of Staff's statement that no party objects to the requested relief, the Commission will now take up Staff's request unopposed.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's Request for Extension of Time to File Staff Report is granted.
2. The Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and intervenors shall file their reports no later than January 8, 2009.
3. This order shall become effective on immediately upon issuance.
