ORDER DIRECTING KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY TO FILE A THIRD REPORT

On August 5, 2010, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) filed an application asking the Commission to waive a provision of its Electric Utility Resource Planning (IRP) regulation to allow KCP&L to delay filing its next IRP submission from November 5, 2011, until April 1, 2012. On September 8, the Commission ordered KCP&L to meet with interested stakeholders regarding the application and to report the result of that meeting by October 8.

KCP&L filed its first progress report on October 7. That report indicated the stakeholders met on several occasions and progress was made. KCP&L indicated an additional meeting was scheduled for October 15, and requested leave to file an additional report after that meeting.

The Commission granted KCP&L's request and the company filed a second report on October 21. The second report indicated the parties are still talking and requested that KCP&L be allowed to file an additional report after the next meeting, which is scheduled for October 27.

The Commission will grant KCP&L's request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Kansas City Power & Light Company shall file an additional report regarding the results of its stakeholder meetings no later than November 5, 2010.
- 2. Any other participant in the meetings may file a separate report no later than November 5, 2010.
 - 3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
