## ORDER DIRECTING KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY TO FILE A FOURTH REPORT

On August 5, 2010, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) filed an application asking the Commission to waive a provision of its Electric Utility Resource Planning (IRP) regulation to allow KCP&L to delay filing its next IRP submission from November 5, 2011, until April 1, 2012. The Commission ordered KCP&L to meet with interested stakeholders regarding the application and to report the result of that meeting.

After several meetings, and after filing several progress reports, KCP&L filed a report on November 5, indicating it has not been able to reach a consensus with the interested stakeholders. The company now asks the Commission to allow it until November 19 to reassess its position. The Commission will grant KCP&L's request.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company shall file an additional report no later than November 19, 2010.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
