On October 8, 2019, Ameren Missouri filed a request for a variance from some of its tariffs and from some of the Commission’s rules to allow it to implement its Advanced Metering Infrastructure. The Commission will order notice of this application, and will set a date for intervention requests.¹

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall send a copy of this order to the City of St. Louis and to the county commissions in Ameren Missouri’s service territory.
2. The Commission’s Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make this notice available to the members of the General Assembly serving in Ameren Missouri’s service territory.
3. Any person or entity wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene no later than October 23, 2019.
