## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

Issue Date: July 22, 2020 Effective Date: July 22, 2020

On June 23, 2020, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri) filed an application seeking variance from certain provisions of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8)(A), concerning information to be reported in Ameren Missouri's Annual Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report.

On July 10, 2020, Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) filed an application to intervene. MIEC's application contends its interests are different from the general public and may be adversely affected by a final order in this case. More than 10 days have passed since MIEC applied to intervene; no party has objected to MIEC's application.

After considering the unopposed application to intervene, the Commission finds that allowing MIEC to intervene will serve the public interest.<sup>1</sup>

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. MIEC's application to intervene is granted.
- 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
