6	Q:	Please state your name and business address.
7	A:	My name is David L. Wagner. My business address is 1201 Walnut, Kansas City,
8		Missouri 64106.
9	Q:	By whom and in what capacity are you employed?
10	A:	I am employed by Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") as Supervisor,
11		Channel Solutions.
12	Q.	What are your responsibilities?
13	A.	My current responsibilities include supervision of KCPL's commercial sales in Kansas
14		and Missouri, as well as, residential electric heat pump sales for new subdivision homes
15		and existing customers converting from air conditioning units to heat pumps. Our
16		group's commercial efforts include working with customers, architects, engineers,
17		contractors and facility managers to provide energy use analysis of new and existing
18		buildings. In particular, we focus on the building's HVAC system, system alternatives
19		and the various electric rate options available from KCP&L. One of our main goals is to
20		provide customers economical rate options and building HVAC solutions.
21	Q.	Please describe your education, experience and employment history.
22	A.	My college degree is Bachelor of Science, Landscape Architecture, from Kansas State
23		University. I've been employed by KCPL for over 24 years, serving in both sales and

1 marketing as a Technical Professional. In this role I provided building energy	gy use

- 2 analysis for other KCPL sales and marketing staff, for customers, and for architects,
- 3 engineers and other trade allies in the commercial building industry. I have been in a
- 4 supervisory capacity for just over five years.
- 5 Q. Have you previously testified in a proceeding at the Missouri Public Service
- 6 Commission or before any other utility regulatory agency?
- 7 A. No, I have not.
- 8 Q. What is the purpose of your testimony?
- 9 A. The purpose of my testimony is to confirm that KCPL is capable of providing economic
- electric service to generate steam heat to Truman Medical Center ("TMC"). I also
- explain that KCPL offers its customers a comprehensive energy consumption analysis,
- including electric heat.
- 13 Q. On page 12, lines 10-11 of Mr. Kirk's testimony, he states "Trigen believes that
- KCP&L can not economically offer this customer [TMC] a viable alternative by
- selling electricity to generate steam heat." Do you believe KCP&L can provide
- economic electric service to generate steam heat to TMC?
- 17 A. Yes. KCPL provides economic electric service to its customers used for heating, cooling,
- lighting, water heating, motors, process power and many other uses.
- 19 Q. In the last 12 months, was KCPL asked by TMC to provide any energy alternative
- for TMC's central heating cooling plant?
- 21 A. No, to my knowledge KCPL has not been asked by TMC to provide energy alternatives
- for the central heating cooling plant.

1 Q. Does KCPL provide this type of analysis for customers?

- 2 A. Yes, KCPL routinely provides detailed energy analysis, that includes such items as;
- 3 energy use and load estimates, equipment evaluation and selection, and economic
- 4 analyses for heating and cooling systems. These analyses are customized to the
- 5 customer's specific requirements and needs.

6 Q. Does KCPL analyze the "outsourcing" of central heating cooling plant?

- 7 A. Yes, through KCPL's analysis and its vendor partners, KCPL provides complete analysis
- 8 and facilitates "turn-key" installation proposals to customers. Vendor installations can
- 9 include guaranteed, fixed price, all inclusive service options.
- 10 Q. Does that conclude your testimony?
- 11 A. Yes, it does.
