Rulemaking Case EX-2010-0169 Renewable Energy Standard

EDITORIAL ITEMS:

EDITORIAL ITEM 1.

(1) Definitions.

- (K) Renewable energy resource(s) means electric energy produced from the following:
 - 1. Wind;

2. Solar, including solar thermal sources utilized to generate electricity, photovoltaic cells, or panels;

Remove comma in the phrase "photovoltaic cells or panels".

EDITORIAL ITEM 2.

9. Fuel cells using hydrogen produced by one (1) of the renewable energy technologies in paragraphs 1. through 8.

The word "one" in this item is being used as an article, as the word "an" in the phrase "Hydrogen` produced by *an* energy technology". The inclusion of "(1)" indicates the sense of "one and <u>only</u> one".

The phrase "produced by one of the renewable energy technologies" is not meant to exclude hydrogen produced from *more than one* renewable energy technology.

Remove "(1)" from the phrase "One of the renewable energy technologies".

EDITORIAL ITEM 3.

(1) Definitions.

(Q) Solar renewable energy credit or S-REC means an REC created by generation of electric energy from solar thermal sources, photovoltaic cells, and panels;

Remove comma in the phrase "photovoltaic cells or panels". See item for Section (1) (K) above.

EDITORIAL ITEM 4.

(2) Requirements.

(G) ... The independent auditor shall be unaffiliated with the electric utility and shall not, directly or indirectly, have benefited from employment or contracts with the utility in the preceding five (5) years...

PROPOSED REVISION: Revise the phrase to read "shall not have directly or indirectly benefited".

MINOR ITEM 5.

- (5) Retail Rate Impact.
 - (B) The comparison of the rate impact of renewable and non-renewable energy resources shall be conducted only when the electric utility proposes to add incremental renewable energy resource generation <u>through the procurement</u> <u>or development</u> of renewable energy resources.

This language can be interpreted to include procurement by anyone, not just the utility.

Change the word "the" into the word "internal or contracted".
