# ORDER CONCERNING POST-EVIDENTIARY HEARING BRIEFS

Issue Date: October 24, 2018 Effective Date: October 24, 2018 On October 23, 2018, the Commission conducted an evidentiary hearing. The Commission will issue its order concerning post-evidentiary hearing briefs.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Stella Lucy and the Office of Public Counsel may, and Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri (the "Company") and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (the "Staff") shall file briefs no later than December 6, 2018. Stella Lucy, the Office of Public Counsel, the Company, and the Staff (collectively, the "Parties") may file reply briefs. Reply briefs shall be filed no later than December 21, 2018.

- 2. All Parties shall address the following points in their briefs:
  - The Parties shall identify, with arguments and reasons, the issues which each believes require resolution by the Commission. The Parties shall specifically address the Commission's authority, if any, to

grant Stella Lucy the relief which she has requested. The Parties shall specifically address the issue of whether the Company's conduct and/or Stella Lucy's transfer switch caused or contributed to cause Stella Lucy's alleged injuries and damages.

- The Parties shall identify, with arguments and reasons, the statutes, regulations and/or tariffs which each believe govern the disposition of this case. The Parties shall specifically identify the Company's duties, if any, in this case.
- The Parties shall identify, with arguments and reasons, the material facts in evidence which they contend govern the disposition of this case.
- 3. This order shall become effective when issued.
