## NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

**COMES NOW** the Office of the Public Counsel (""Public Counsel") and for its Notice of Dismissal, states:

1. On April 7, 2023, in Case No. ER-2022-0337, Public Counsel, Ameren, and other parties filed an agreement to resolve a number of issues raised in that case. The agreement also includes a term that would resolve the issue raised in these complaint cases. That term states:

Customer Deposits: Ameren Missouri agrees that by the end of 2023, it will implement a change to its policy on residential customer security deposits so that security deposits for residential customers are returned after 12 months of satisfactory bill payments regardless of whether the customer paid the deposit in installments. This policy change will also apply to Ameren Missouri's residential gas customers. These agreements regarding residential customer deposit policy changes resolve File Nos. EC-2023-0257 and GC-2023-0258, which shall be dismissed upon approval of this *Stipulation*.

- 2. On June 14, 2023, the Commission issued a Report and Order approving the Stipulation. New tariffs implementing the Report and Order became effective on July 9, 2023.
- 3. For the above reasons, and pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.116(1), the Office of the Public Counsel dismisses complaint case numbers EC-2023-0257 and GC-2023-0258.
