1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 JUDGE JONES: We'll go on the record  
3 with case number EC-2007-0273, Marlyn Young versus  
4 AmerenUE. It is now 10:15, and none of the parties  
5 are present. We will therefore cancel the hearing and  
6 go off the record.

7 (A phone call was received.)

8 JUDGE JONES: We will stay on. Mr. Burn,  
9 how are you today?

10 MR. BURN: Good, other than we're having  
11 some calling-in issues.

12 JUDGE JONES: Well, you're here now, and

11    probably issue an order asking him to tell me why he

13    reschedule.

14                  I don't want to waste more time on this though.  
15    The purpose of the pre-hearing conference is for you  
16    all to get together and talk, for the most part.   I  
17    might issue an order telling the parties to just do  
18    that.   How does that sound to you?

19                  MR. BURN:   Okay.   That sounds fine to me,  
20    Judge.

21                  JUDGE JONES:   OPC hasn't participated in  
22    this at all, I don't believe.   I will direct staff  
23    then, who also play a part -- I mean, maybe they may  
24    be able to, I don't know, mediate in some way.   So,  
25    that's what I'll probably do from here.
