ORDER DIRECTING THAT SCHEDULE BE MADE PUBLIC

On February 27, 2008, the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. filed Schedule JPP-7 as a highly confidential attachment to the otherwise public surrebuttal testimony of its witness Johannes Pfeifenberger. Subsequently, that document was admitted into evidence at the hearing as part of highly confidential exhibit 7HC. On April 22, Aquila, Inc. filed a notice indicating that the information contained in Schedule JPP-7 has been made public in another context and consequently no longer needs to be treated as highly confidential. Aquila indicates it does not object to the reclassification of that schedule as a public document.

Since the information contained in Schedule JPP-7 is no longer highly confidential, the Commission will direct its data center to reclassify that document from highly confidential to public. For the same reason, the testimony admitted at the hearing as exhibit 7HC shall be reclassified as a public document.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Commission's data center shall reclassify Schedule JPP-7, which is attached to the surrebuttal testimony of Johannes Pfeifenberger, as a public document.
2. The testimony admitted into evidence at the hearing as exhibit 7HC is reclassified as a public document.
3. This order shall become effective on May 1, 2008.
