## ORDER DIRECTING AN EXPEDITED STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Issue Date: August 12, 2020 Effective Date: August 12, 2020

On August 11, 2020, The Empire District Electric Company (Empire) filed tariff sheet revisions (YE-2021-0023 and YW-2021-0024) to explain that for Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) opt out customers, Empire's default procedure will be to disable the two-communication portion of the AMI meter. The use of non-standard (non-AMI) meters will continue to be an option for customers so long as those meters are available. Empire states that these tariff changes have no impact on rates or charges. The tariff sheets have a September 10, 2020, effective date.

In consideration of the tariff's effective date, the Commission will direct its Staff to file a recommendation on an expedited schedule. The Commission will also establish a deadline for any other entity to file a response to the tariff sheets or Staff's recommendation.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than August 17, 2020, Staff shall file a recommendation regarding the tariff sheets filed by Empire.

- 2. Any other entity wanting to comment on the tariff sheets or Staff's recommendation shall do so no later than August 19, 2020.
  - 3. This order is effective when issued.
