**ORDER ESTABLISHING PARTIAL PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE TO
CONSIDER CHANGE REQUESTS**

On July 3, 2014, the Commission’s Staff and Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed separate change requests asking the Commission to make certain changes to the impact evaluation portion of the final EM&V (evaluation, measurement, and verification) Reports prepared by Ameren Missouri’s independent evaluators and filed in this case on June 12, 2014. A stipulation and agreement approved by the Commission in this case in 2012 establishes procedures for the consideration of such change requests. In particular, it provides that the Commission will establish a procedural schedule to complete a hearing on such requests within 60 days of their filing.

The Commission initially established a procedural schedule that would have led to an evidentiary hearing on August 28 and 29. That hearing date was subsequently extended until September 24 and 25, and then indefinitely suspended. On September 19, Staff and Ameren Missouri filed a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement to resolve their disagreements about the change requests. Public Counsel objected to that stipulation and agreement and requested a hearing. In response, the Commission directed the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than October 1.

Staff and Ameren Missouri filed a proposed procedural schedule that would lead to a hearing on January 6 and 7, 2015. Public Counsel proposed a procedural schedule that would have a hearing on October 23 and 24. The one thing that both schedules agree upon is that Public Counsel, and presumably other parties, should respond to the Change Requests on October 6.

The Commission will direct that stakeholder responses to any change requests be filed on October 6. Thereafter, the Commission will have an opportunity to consider the competing proposed procedural schedules at its October 8 agenda meeting.


